Ontario's Corporate Immigration Services

- The Ontario Ministry of Economic Development, Trade & Employment, Business Immigration Branch offers corporate immigration advisory services to new and existing Ontario employers.
- These corporate immigration advisory services include:
 - providing information and guidance to Ontario employers and investors on temporary foreign worker and permanent residency options; and
 - providing guidance to companies on the process and procedures for making an application for temporary resident visas, temporary work permits or permanent residency.

Corporate Immigration – Common Questions

- Ontario's Business Immigration provides information on:
 - Labour Market Opinions – the regular process to hire a temporary foreign worker in Canada
 - Intra-Company Transfers – a facilitated work permit process to move executive, managerial and specialized staff from abroad to Canada
 - Business Visitors – a visa for business people coming to Canada for a short period of time and who are not entering the Canadian labour market
 - Other temporary foreign worker program options for key staff and their dependents
 - Permanent residency programs – Federal Skilled Worker Program, Canadian Experience Class and the Opportunities Ontario Provincial Nominee Program
