Introduction to Lean Productivity (Lean 101)

In this module, participants will be provided with a thorough overview of applying Lean to boost productivity in a variety of applications. Key takeaways are understanding how to identify the *8 deadly wastes*, know the *basics of 5S*, *Effective Problem Solving*, *Value Stream Mapping*, *Kaizen* and *Total Productive Maintenance*.

Introduction to Lean Management Systems

Lean Management is about more than just managing in a lean workplace. We will challenge old management models through introducing concepts supporting the people of the organization and implementing leader standard work. Leadership will be a large component of this module.

Productivity Action Plan Development

Using the problem solving tool called an A3, we expect participants to apply their learning to real world problems within their individual value streams.

Participants will learn about the A3 and be coached in its use to achieve meaningful improvements.

Introduction to Value Stream Mapping

Value Stream Mapping is one of the most powerful tools to map out the current state, identify the future state, align people to company and customer, and is a great tool to help prioritize future improvement activities. In a world where time, money and resources are in limited supply, this tool is most valuable to keep focus on what is most important.

Leadership and Culture for Productivity Improvement

This module will focus on the critical link between leadership and the culture of an organization. Culture can be shaped by the actions of the leaders in the organization. Using our model of organizational culture, we will discuss strategies to shape culture to be ready for Lean implementation.

Productivity / Lean Tools

Providing a more focused and in depth view of the Lean tools, participants can expect to acquire a working knowledge of the core tools that will help achieve real productivity improvements and be applied to each participant's improvement project.
