A FIRST OF ITS KIND! MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) SIGNED BETWEEN CANADA AND INDIA

Windsor-Essex, Ontario Canada – November 29, 2018 – On November 28, 2018 the Canadian Association of Mold Maker (CAMM) and WindsorEssex Economic Development Corporation (WE EDC) signed two Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Engineering Export Promotion Council (EEPC) India and the Tools and Gauge Manufacturer's Association of India (TAGMA). This is an effort by the Canadian Association of Mold Makers member companies Canada-wide and WE EDC to explore opportunities in the Indian market.
